GRICE PROTAGONIST AT EUROPEAN KF2 CHAMPIONSHIP

Once again, PDB Racing Team is protagonist at international level. Directed by Peter de Bruijn and assisted by PDB technical staff, Matt Truelove, Florian Alfano, Jonathan Walker, Tom Grice, Leopold Ringbom, Felix Fröjd, and Robert Butler went to Braga (P) to take part in the 3rd round of the European KF1 Championship and the European KF2 Championship final.

In the queen class, following the good performance in the previous events, Truelove is once again protagonist in the two finals, getting valuable points for the championship (12). After being up with the leaders in the qualifying heats, Truelove takes 11th in Final 1, while in Final 2 is forced in the mid group. In Final 2 Alfano and Walker make up for a disappointing result in Final 1, where the two were involved in an early accident.

In KF2, Tom Grice is protagonist already in the qualifying heats: he wins one of the most competitive heats on Sunday morning, and thanks to the positive results in the other heats - where he's always within the top three - he starts prefinal from third grid. Grice is very fast off the green lights, but a contact in lap 3 forces him to the back of the field, compromising his hopes of success in the final.

The events that will see PDB Racing Team fighting for the win in the near future are the World Cup for KZ1 and the European KZ2/KF3 Championship final in Varennes (F) on 7th September, and the World KF1 Championship and World Cup for KF2 in La Conca on 21st September.
