**J**ust to remind you, during four racing weekend there were eight rounds and two finals in each round. Sixty-seven competitors raced in five categories.

In the international **KF2** category eight competitors tried their best. Despite the fact that there were not many participants, races were interesting and full of unexpected action turnovers. Winner and Champion of Poland 2009 Kuba Smiechowski provided spectators with strong emotions. He won six races and took second position five times. It is worth to say that Kuba participated in Italian Formula Renault 2.0. For the crown of Champion he fought with Mateusz Rzu-

cidlo, Norbert Staczyk and only one girl in this category - Maja Moeller. Winner of two races, Staczyk gained the title of vice-champion of Poland, ahead of Rzucidlo.

The **KF3** category is the least numerous class in Poland. Though this is an international class and should be liked by drivers, it's not so for the sponsors, as it's quite expensive.

Only six drivers disputed the crown of Champion fighting it out in six races. Finally, the title went to Filip Tomporek who won four out of six finals. Bartosz Mruk became the vice-champion and Patryk Ptaszek, who is the son of well-known rally cross driver Jacek, finished third.
